Notice Regarding Unauthorized Access to Data Server

Nippon Ceramic Co., Ltd. (hereafter the “Company”) hereby announces that it has been confirmed that our data server has been illegally accessed by a third party, and it has been discovered that some of the information held by us may have been leaked.

With the assistance of external professionals, we are currently working to identify the cause and extent of the impact, and to restore the damage. It is expected to take some time to ascertain the full extent of the damage, the following are reports on what are confirmed at this moment.

We deeply apologize for any inconvenience and concern this may cause to our business partners and other concerned parties.

1. Back Ground

On April 7, 2025, at around 8:00 a m., a failure in our data server was detected, and upon investigation, it was confirmed that the data server had been illegally accessed by a third party on April 5, 2025. Immediately, with the assistance of external professionals, we have begun to identify the extent of the damage and to investigate the cause and route of an unauthorized access.

2. Current Situation and Future Actions

Immediately shut down the data servers and other facilities that has been illegally accessed from the Internet and internal networks. We reported to the system’s company, and then, with their support, we work with them to deal with the situation. We will promptly provide more detailed information on the extent of damage, the cause of unauthorized access, and plans for system restoration as soon as the situation becomes clearer.

3. Information Leakage

We are still conducting an investigation to identify information (confidential information including personal information, etc.) that may have been leaked, with the assistance of external professionals. If any matters arise during the course of the investigation that should be disclosed, we will disclose them immediately.

In addition, we will consult with the police and report this matter to the Personal Information Protection Commission.

4. Future Prospections

Impact of this matter on our business plan is currently under scrutiny. If any matter requiring disclosure arises, we will promptly disclose it.
